### NOTICE ESTABLISHING ELECTRONIC DATA INTERCHANGE WORK GROUP

**To: Maryland Electric Utilities; Maryland Active Electric Suppliers; Office of People's Counsel; Technical Staff of the Public Service Commission; and Other Interested Persons**

The Public Service Commission ("Commission") hereby re-establishes the "Electronic Data Interchange ('EDI') Work Group" for the purpose of addressing EDI transaction standards and procedures in support of the recently adopted COMAR 20.53 regulations, including the provision for purchase of receivables. The Commission directs its Technical Staff to facilitate the Work Group. The Work Group should be composed of stakeholders from electric utilities, electric suppliers, OPC, and other customer groups' representatives that wish to participate in the Work Group on a voluntary basis.

Previously, an EDI Work Group was convened by the Commission and the Work Group established EDI operating and testing procedures, as well as published the Maryland EDI transaction documents, *e.g.*, the various transaction implementation guides. The Work Group also may wish to address EDI housekeeping issues and consistency with regional standards and procedures, as needed. Staff shall file any suggested revisions to the existing standards with the Commission for administrative approval.
