NOTICE OF HEARING TO CONSIDER THE COMPLIANCE PLANS AND ASSOCIATED TARIFF REVISIONS FILED PURSUANT TO COMAR 20.59

To: Participants in RM 35 and Interested Persons:

On October 8, 2009 and pursuant to COMAR 20.59.01.04, the following gas or gas and electric utilities ("Utilities") filed compliance plans to implement the Competitive Gas Supply regulations, COMAR 20.59, as finally adopted by the Public Service Commission ("Commission"). In addition, the Utilities filed associated tariff revisions incorporating certain provisions of the applicable compliance plan. The Utilities filing such plans and associated tariff revisions are:

Baltimore Gas and Electric Company (Mail Log No. 119139);

Pivotal Utility Holdings, Inc. d/b/a Elkton Gas (Mail Log No. 119127);
