TAKE NOTICE THAT Staff of the New York State Department of Public Service (Staff) will host a technical conference on Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) on April 14 and 15, 2008 at the Desmond Hotel and Conference Center, 660 Albany Shaker Road, Albany, New York. The purpose of the conference is to aid Staff in its efforts to develop minimum functional requirements for utility AMI systems by increasing its knowledge and understanding of this rapidly evolving and technically complex subject.

Topics for discussion at the conference include the following: overview of AMI systems, smart grid systems and their relationship to AMI systems, AMI communication protocols and platforms, meter data access issues, and AMI meter and system capabilities.
