**NOTICE OF HEARING**

**To: The Parties and Interested Persons**

The Public Service Commission (“Commission”) hereby gives notice to the parties in this matter that the Commission has scheduled a legislative-style hearing on Thursday, February 10, 2011. The hearing will begin at 10 a.m. in the Commission’s 16<sup>th</sup> Floor Hearing Room, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. The purpose of the hearing is to consider whether curtailment service providers (“CSPs”) operating in Maryland should be subject to licensing as electricity suppliers pursuant to § 7-507 of the Public Utilities Article, *Annotated Code of Maryland*. Further, the Commission also will consider whether to require periodic reports from the CSPs in the event that the Commission determines that the CSPs are subject to licensing by the Commission.
