NOTICE OF RULEMAKING, NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR COMMENTS,  
AND NOTICE OF WORKSHOP

The Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (“Commission”) has opened an Investigation and Rulemaking to consider amending certain regulations contained in Chapter 704 of the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”) relating to alternative sellers of discretionary natural gas service to update the regulations with existing practices, consistent with ordering paragraph 2 of the July 19, 2019, Order in Docket No. 19-06038. This matter has been designated as Docket No. 19-07017.

This matter is conducted pursuant to the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and NAC Chapters 233B, 703, and 704, including, but not limited to, NRS 703.025 and 704.210.

Interested and affected persons may file comments at either of the Commission’s offices on or before WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2019. Comments should include proposed language to amend NAC 704.79501 to 704.79545, NAC 704.79527, NAC 704.79529, repeal NAC 704.79531, and otherwise revise the regulations in NAC Chapter 704 to bring the existing regulations up to date with existing practices and realities of alternative sellers of discretionary natural gas service; and explore whether the disparities in notification deadlines/timeframes that transportation customers must submit in order to recommence sales service within the local distribution company are still warranted; and whether an opportunity to elect sales service from the local distribution company should be available more than once a year. Interested and affected persons may file reply comments at either of the Commission’s offices on or before WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 30, 2019.
